Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India (DFCCIL) is a Special Purpose Vehicle set up under the administrative control of Ministry of Railways to undertake planning & development, mobilization of financial resources and construction, maintenance and operation of the Dedicated Freight Corridors.

The Eastern and Western dedicated freight corridors are the much-needed additions to Indian Railways freight carrying capacity. The ambitious project was launched in 2006. Eastern DFC (EDFC) spans a length of 1,856 km from Ludhiana (Punjab) to Dankuni (West Bengal). The Western DFC (WDFC) entails the development of 1,506 km from Dadri (UP) to JN Port Trust (Mah.).

The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Limited (DMRC) was registered in May 1995 with equal equity participation of the Government of the National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) and the Central Government.

The first line of Delhi Metro was opened in 2002. Presently, the Delhi Metro network consists of about 390 Km with 286 stations. The network has now crossed the boundaries of Delhi to reach NOIDA and Ghaziabad in Uttar Pradesh, Gurgaon, Faridabad, Bahadurgarh and Ballabhgarh in Haryana. The Delhi Metro is the first ever railway project in the world to claim carbon credits for regenerative braking.
